NOTIFICATION PLACARD FOR OIL SPILLS IN WASHINGTON STATE WATERS

(except the Columbia River System in which case notify M.F.S.A. 503-220-2055)

In the event of a spill or potential spill in the offshore waters of Washington, the Straits of Juan de Fuca, Puget Sound or Grays Harbor:

**1 - FIRST - NOTIFY WSMC IMMEDIATELY AND DIRECTLY,
DO NOT RELAY THIS CALL**

**2 - SECOND - NOTIFY THE VESSEL'S QUALIFIED INDIVIDUAL (QI),
DO NOT RELAY THIS CALL**

The QI and their contact information is named in the Federal Vessel Response Plan for the vessel.
